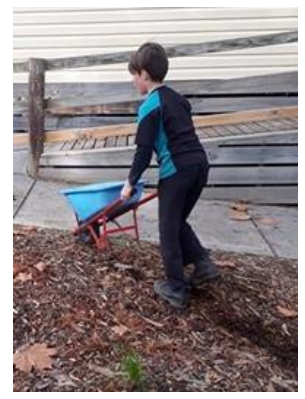
For the last two weeks of term Katy has been unwell and Tammy Estcourt is filling her role until the end of Term 2. We hope everyone has a refreshing break.
