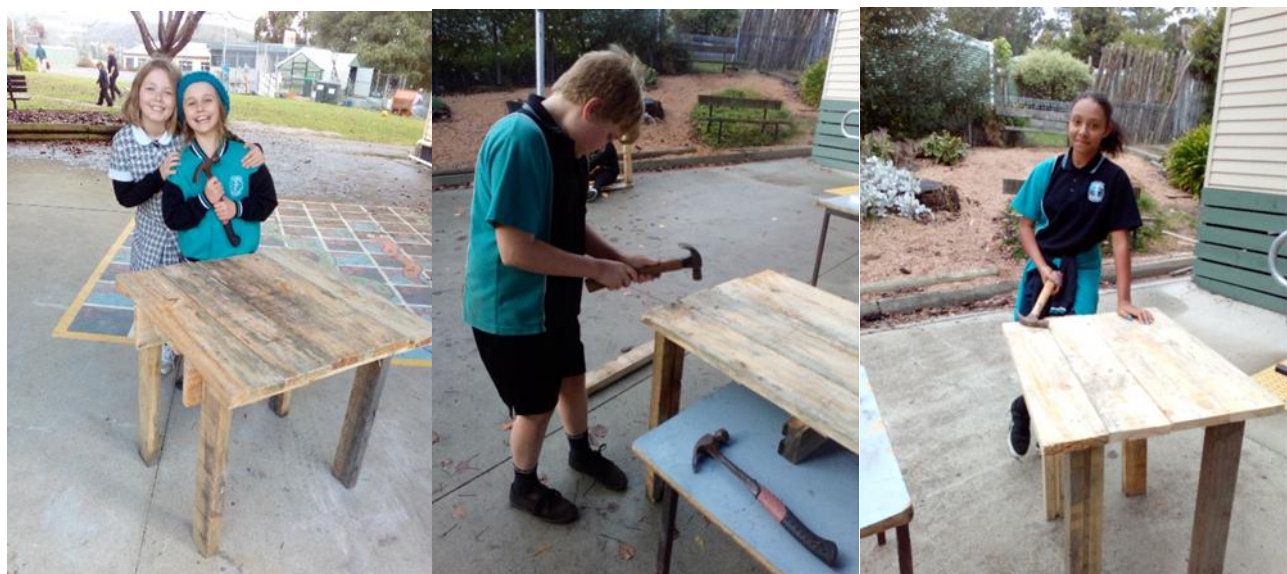


Life Styles for Term 3
